

## Registration

To enter each contestant must fill out one: Contest Registration Form per person and one Contest Entry Form per entry. All forms are available on our website, and Facebook page. See the Contest Page for Categories, Eligibility, Judging and Rules. Print the forms at home and fill them out before the contest.

Please note that contest registration ends at 1pm and judging begins immediately afterward.

## Fees

### General Admission

- Adults: \$5.00
- Youths (ages 6-16) \$2.00
- Children (age 5 & under): Free
- If entered in contest: Free

### Contest Entry

- Adults \$10.00 – First Model
  - \$2.00 – For Each Additional Model
- Juniors \$5.00 – First Model
  - \$1.00 – For Each Additional Model
- Beginners \$1.00 – Each Model

### Door Prizes

- First ticket included free with a General Admission Ticket or Contest Entry.
- Additional tickets available for a \$1 each.
- Winning tickets are drawn with numbers posted to a white board
- Winners are drawn periodically throughout the day and may pick the prize of their choice from those available.
- Prize table is replenished throughout the day, so be sure to buy plenty of tickets, and check the table often.

## Vendor Information

### Vendor Tables

- 96 tables are available for rent at Modelmania.
- The cost for an 8' x 28" table is \$35 each.
- If you reserve six tables or more, you may get one additional table free. If reserving ten tables or more, you may get two additional tables free.
- Payment may be made by cash, check or money order made out to IPMS-Houston.
- Tables may be reserved in advance via email to Tony Bohnert, Vendor Coordinator (see bottom of page).
- Please submit payment to the Vendor Coordinator prior to the show date.
- "No show" vendors who do not contact the Vendor Coordinator 48 hours prior to the show will be billed for the tables they have reserved. Each year, we usually have a number of vendors who cancel out at the last minute, tables can usually be resold the day of the event if we know a person is not coming. We trust you understand our policy.

### Electrical Outlets

- Electrical outlets are available but are very limited.
- If you should need an electrical outlet, please contact the Vendor Coordinator, so you may be placed near an outlet.
- **Please note:** Our contract with the Stafford Convention Centre, allows the Centre to charge \$40 per table for electrical hook-ups. However, this has not been enforced in the past. If you require an outlet, please bring an additional \$40 in the event the Centre's Coordinator insists that this fee be paid during set-up
- You will need to bring an extension cord (minimum 20' heavy duty cord). Cords must be secured to the floor using only gaffer tape. Any damages to the carpet will be the responsibility of the Vendor.
- We also have WiFi hook ups available if paid in advance at \$30.00 per connection.
- Please note table skirts and extension cords are not provided.

### Reserving Tables

To reserve a table, fill out the form below and email to Tony Bohnert. When reserving tables, please provide us with the number of tables you need, whether an electrical hook-up is needed, and a current telephone number.

### Venue

- All vendors must use the loading dock to unload and load.
- The Stafford Centre loading dock doors (on the south side of the building) open at 6:30 a.m. on the morning of the show.
- Volunteers will be available to help you unload (only).
- A limited number of carts to move your items to your table(s) will be available, so if you have a dolly please bring it.
- After unloading, vendors will need to move their vehicles to the front parking lot of the Stafford Centre.

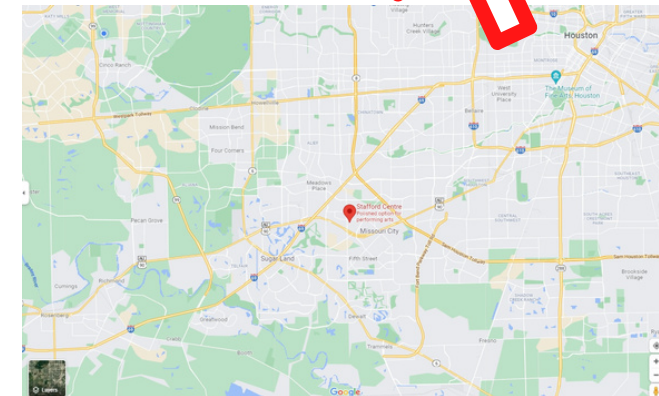
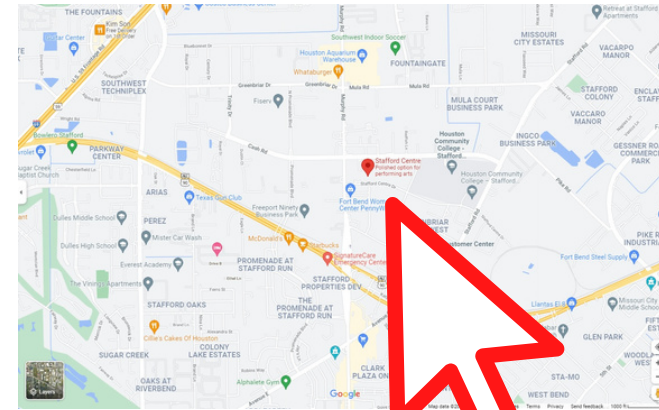
